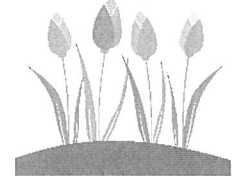
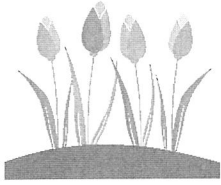


# Kindergarten
